

Acceptable form of Identification

The list below identifies the **acceptable documents** that a PIV Applicant **must bring at the time of identity proofing and registration.**

The PIV Applicant **must bring *two*** of these documents, one of which must be a **Federal or State-issued photo identification.** The documents **must be originals.**

Primary Forms of Identification

- **FAA ID Badge**
- **U.S. Passport** (unexpired)
- **Permanent Resident Card** or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
- **An unexpired foreign passport** with a temporary I-551 stamp
- **An unexpired Employment Authorization Document** that contains a photograph (Form I-766, I-688, I-688A, I-688B)
- **An unexpired foreign passport with an unexpired Arrival-Departure Record, Form I-94,** bearing the same name as the passport and containing an endorsement of the alien's non-immigrant status, if that status authorizes the alien to work for the employer
- **Driver's license or ID card issued by a state** or outlying possession of the United States provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color and address
- **ID card issued by federal, state or local government** agencies or entities, provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color and address
- **School ID card** with a photograph
- **Voter's registration card**
- **U.S. Military card** or draft record
- **Military dependent's ID card**
- **U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card**
- **Native American tribal document**
- **Driver's license issued by a Canadian government authority**
- **U.S. Social Security card** issued by the Social Security Administration (other than a card stating it is not valid for employment)
- **Certification of Birth Abroad** issued by the Department of State (Form FS-545 or Form DS-1350)
- **Original or certified copy of a birth certificate** issued by a state, county, municipal authority or outlying possession of the United States bearing an official seal
- **U.S. Citizen ID Card (Form I-197)**
- **ID Card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States (Form I-179)**
- **Unexpired employment authorization document issued by DHS**

For persons under age 18 who are unable to present one of the documents listed above:

- **School record or report card**
- **Clinic, doctor or hospital record**
- **Day-care or nursery school record**
