

Maintaining Your FAA PIV Credential




It is your responsibility to protect your FAA PIV credential and exercise the same care with it as you do with other identification credentials. **For best protection, please keep your card in your FAA-issued badge holder.**


Other Protective Measures:



DO NOT mark on, punch holes in, or bend the credential. This could cause the antenna inside to break, and may cause the protective plastic covering to peel away prematurely.



AVOID exposing your credential to excessive heat (e.g., clothes dryer, car dashboards) as the card could warp.



DO NOT store the credential near magnetic fields (e.g., stereo equipment, magnets, or other magnetic stripe cards, etc.).
